WASTE	WHAT TO INSERT
Paper collection	Paper, Cardboard, Cardboard Packaging, Newspapers, Magazines, etc.
light multi-material waste collection	Plastic Bottles and Containers, Soap, Shampoo and Shower gel bottles, etc., Metal Cans and Jars, Polyester and Plastic Food Trays, Tetrapak, Plastic Plates and Cups
Compost collection	Leftover food (cooked and/or raw), fruit and/or vegetable waste, Gardening waste, Dirty paper napkins, small wood containers (the compost goes in closed bags)
Glass collection	Glass bottles, Glass jars, Glass cups (the glass goes loose, not in a bag)
RUR collection (Unsorted waste)	All waste that doesn't fall under separate collection – like ceramics, plastic silverware, nappies, CDs and DVDs, toys, etc., for example – makes up RUR (Residual Urban Refuse)
